



So, you want to visit a pond?

Northern Utah is home to many ponds where you can take your Ponds Scavenger hunt or just go for a walk and look for cool things. Here is a short list of some you might want to visit:

Ogden area:

1. **Ponds at Ogden Nature Center** -- The Nature Center, at 966 W. 12th Street, in Ogden, has 10 or more ponds, depending on the time of year. The ones easiest to access are Arrowhead Pond and Teal Pond. make sure to grab a map when you check in at the Visitor Center.
2. **Beus Pond** -- Beus Pond, at 4240 Country Hills Drive, in Ogden. Paved pathway and lots of ducks and geese.
3. **The 21st Street Pond** -- This lake-like pond at 650 W. 20th Street, in Ogden, has a paved, 1.2-mile trail around it.
4. **Glassman Pond** -- This pond is located at 1151 Oakcrest Drive, in Ogden. You'll find lots of lily pads and vegetation, depending on when you vist.

Davis County:

1. **Kaysville Ponds** -- This pond, located on 50 West between 5500 and 900 South, is a popular fishing spot. But there is plenty to see, too!
2. **Layton Commons Park** -- This duck pond is located in a 47-acre park at 437 N. Wasatch Drive, in Layton. Take a picnic! There are plenty of places to sit and enjoy the day.
3. **Farmington Pond** -- This rustic pond at 750 N. 75 West in Farmington has plenty of birds, bugs, and plants to see along your walk.
4. **George S. & Dolores Dore Eccles Wildlife Education Center** -- The ponds at this center at 1157 S. Waterfowl Way in Farmington, are actually part of the Great Salt Lake's Farmington Bay. But wildlife abounds, In winter, look for Bald Eagles.

Salt Lake City area:

1. **Lee Kay Ponds** -- This pond is in an unlikely spot -- next to a landfill -- at 6601 W. 1300 South, in Salt lake City. But it is a birding hotspot for Northern Utah. Be sure to visit during migration season.
2. **Willow Pond** -- This 4-acre pond is located in Willow Pond Park, 60 59 S. Murray Parkway, just north of the Murray golf course, in Murray. It also has a playground.

3. **Liberty Park Pond** -- This pond full of waterfowl is located in Salt Lake City's popular Liberty Park, which is located between 1300 South and 900 South, between 500 East and 700 East. Be sure to visit the Tracy Aviary when you go!
4. **Sandy Pond** -- Also known as Grandpa's Fish Pond, this is located along the Jordan River Parkway Trail in Sandy, the driveway is off 10000 South (Shields Lane). Google it. You'll find it.

Box Elder County:

1. **Dale Young Nature Park** -- This pretty little birding hotspot is at 1220 Davis St., in Perry. There's a walkway around it, and lots of birds to see.

Logan area:

1. **Cutler Reservoir** -- Head to Benson Marina in Benson, to see this vast and scenic reservoir that provides floodwater control for humans, and amazing nesting and resting spots for birds and other animals. The marina is at 4401-4929 W. 3000 North in Benson.
